MINT SIGNS DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT WITH MICROVISION AND RECEIVES INITIAL ORDER FROM UNIDEN

Sydney, 22nd October 2009: Mint Wireless Limited (ASX: MNW) (“Mint”) announced the signing of an exclusive distribution agreement with Microvision Inc. (NASDAQ: MVIS) (“Microvision”) to distribute a PicoP® display engine enabled accessory **pocket projector** to select Asia-Pacific countries. Microvision is a world leader in the innovation of a new generation of display and imaging products for mobile applications.

Microvision's accessory **pocket projector** uses the revolutionary laser-based PicoP® display engine that delivers large, colorful, bright, and vivid images that are always in focus, regardless of projection distance. The projector is a plug-and-play device for people on-the-go who want to share multimedia applications such as movies, TV, photos and business presentations.

The device can be connected directly to a range of sources, including portable media players, laptops, notebooks, mobile phones and compatible devices such as the Apple iPhone and iPods. Depending on the ambient light, images of up to 200” can be displayed without the user ever having to adjust focus.
